FIFTY-FIFTH CONVOCATION

8th June, 2013

It gives me great pleasure to welcome you all on the occasion of the fifty-fifth convocation of the International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS), Mumbai. The Institute has completed 57 years of its glorious existence and I am happy to report the activities of the International Institute for Population Sciences, for the academic year 2012-2013.

The Institute attained Deemed University status in 1985. As a Deemed University, the Institute started awarding its own Ph. D. degree since 1986. So far the Institute has awarded Ph.D. degrees to 225 students including 11 foreign students. This year 14 students are receiving their Ph.D. degrees. From the academic year 1988-89, the Institute started a one-year degree course leading to the Master of Population Studies (MPS) and so far the Institute has awarded the MPS degree to 463 students. Since 1994-95, the MPS course has also been introduced through distance learning, keeping in view of the increasing demand for training in the field of Population Studies. So far 299 students have been awarded MPS degree through distance learning. From the academic year 2001-2002, the Institute has started a degree course in Master of Philosophy (M. Phil.) in Population Studies. So far 254 students have been awarded the M. Phil. degree in Population Studies.

The Institute since its inception in 1956, was conducting a one-year certificate programme, Certificate in Population Studies (CPS), for trainees

from various countries in Asia and the Pacific region. The course was funded initially by the UNESCAP and later on by the UNFPA. Over the years, through this course the Institute has helped in the training of personnel from various countries of Asia and the Pacific region and our alumni currently occupy key positions in the field of population, health and development in government departments and universities in these countries and in international organisations. From the academic year 1991-92 this programme was re-designated as Diploma in Population Studies (DPS). So far 1173 students from 42 countries around the world have received CPS/DPS certificate/diploma from this Institute. Two tables given in Appendix I furnish country-wise and year-wise number of students who have so far participated in the different teaching programmes of the Institute. From the academic year 2006-07, the Institute has extended its Diploma in Population Studies (DPS) programme through distance learning.

The one-year Diploma course in Health Education (DHE), started from August 1987 was renamed during the academic year 2001-2002 as Diploma in Health Promotion Education (DHPE). So far 463 students have been awarded Diploma in Health Promotion Education, including 28 foreign students. In this convocation 19 students will be receiving their diploma in DHPE. From the academic year 2006-07, the Institute has initiated a new programme, Post Graduate Diploma in Community Healthcare (PGDCH). This course is of fifteen

months duration. The courses, viz., DHPE and PGDCH are conducted by the Family Welfare Training and Research Centre (FWTRC), Mumbai which is affiliated to IIPS, Mumbai. From the academic year 2009-2010, the Institute has introduced a new programme, MA / M.Sc. in Population Studies (2 years course).

ACTIVITIES OF THE INSTITUTE DURING THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2012-2013

The functions of the IIPS can be classified under four categories: teaching, research, consultative services and documentation. The institute has seven academic departments with well qualified faculty members (Appendix -X).

I TEACHING PROGRAMME

I. Regular courses

During the year 2012-13, the Institute offered the following regular courses: (a) Diploma in Health Promotion Education (DHPE), (b) Master of Arts / Science in Population Studies (MA/M.Sc.), (c) Master of Population Studies (MPS), (d) Master of Philosophy in Population Studies (M.Phil.) and (e) Doctor of Philosophy in Population Studies (Ph.D.). Apart from these programmes, the Institute also offers Master of Population Studies (MPS) and Diploma in Population Studies (DPS) through distance learning.

The lists of students who are receiving degrees/diplomas in this convocation are given in Appen- II.

a. Diploma in Health Promotion Education (DHPE)

This course is of one-year duration. During the current academic year, 19 students were on the roll in the course of Diploma in Health Promotion Education. The Family Welfare Training and Research Centre (FWTRC), Mumbai, conducts the course under the auspices of IIPS.

Dr. Sumita Ghosh is the coordinator for the DHPE programme.

b. Master of Arts / Science in Population Studies (MA / M.Sc.)

The Institute has introduced MA/M.Sc. in Population Studies from the academic year 2009-10 for the graduate students who desire to specialize in population studies. This academic year 42 students have been admitted for this two year programme, with fellowship. The list of students receiving MA/MSc degree for this academic year is given in Appendix-II-2.

Dr. H. Lhungdim is the coordinator for the MA/M.Sc. programme.

c. Master of Population Studies (MPS)

Holders of a Master's Degree from recognized universities in relevant social science subjects including statistics and mathematics are eligible for admission to this course. During the current academic year, 46 students were admitted to MPS programme. All are recipients of Government of India fellowship.

Dr. D.A. Nagdeve is the coordinator for the MPS programme.

d. Master of Philosophy (M. Phil) in Population Studies

The second batch of one year M. Phil programme will pass out this year. 35 students will be receiving M. Phil degree this year. The list of students receiving degree in this convocation are presented in Appendix-II-4

Dr. Chander Shekhar is the Co-coordinator of M. Phil Programme.

e Doctor of Philosophy in Population Studies (Ph. D.)

The Institute has well qualified faculty members to guide students who are admitted to the Ph. D. programme on a highly competitive basis. First, they are short-listed based on their academic record. After a written test on Research Methodology, followed by a personal interview, students are admitted to the Ph.D. programme.

Currently 116 students are registered for the Ph. D programme at the Institute at different levels. This academic year, 14 students have completed all the requirements for the award of Ph. D degree. Four students presented their synopsis and 7 students have submitted the thesis. 23 students are recipients of the Government of India Research Fellowship, 77 students are recipients of the UGC Fellowship and 11 students are registered without fellowship, (Appendix IV Table B).

Appendix III (Table 5) provides the list of Ph.D.

students who will be receiving degree in this convocation.

Prof. P. Arokiasamy is the coordinator for the Ph. D. programme.

II. DISTANCE LEARNING COURCESES

In addition to the above regular courses, IIPS delivers some of the courses through distance learning method. We are happy to inform that our institute has been recognized by the Distance Education Council for offering MPS and DPS through distance learning.

f. Master of Population Studies (Distance Learning)

This course is of two years duration, although students have the flexibility of completing it in a maximum period of four years. In view of the increasing demand, the MPS Distance Learning Programme is also open to students from other ESCAP countries. Currently 434 students are enrolled for this programme. During the year 2012-13, twenty seven students have completed all the requirements for the award of MPS degree (Distance Learning). It is mandatory for the students of Distance Learning to prepare a research paper. Appendix III (Table F) provides the titles of the research papers prepared by the MPS - Distance learning students.

Prof. Balram Paswan is the coordinator for the MPS (Distance learning) programme.

g. Diploma in Population Studies (DPS) (Distance Learning)

In view of the increasing demand, this is a new initiative from the academic year 2006-07. This course is of minimum one year duration, although students have the flexibility of completing it in a maximum period of three years. Currently 156 students, including three foreign students, are enrolled for this programme. This academic year, 1 foreign student has completed all requirements for the award of DPS (Distance learning).

Prof. Balram Paswan is the coordinator for the DPS (Distance Learning) programme.

SEMINAR PAPERS

Towards the end of the second semester, as a part of MA/M.Sc/ MPS/ M. Phil. regular course, each student is required to prepare a research paper (for MPS programme) / a dissertation (for MA/M.Sc/ M.Phil. programmes) under the guidance of a faculty member. The students have to present the paper in a specially organised 'Student-Faculty Seminar'. It is mandatory for all the students to attend the student-faculty seminar. The presented papers /dissertations are later finalised on the basis of discussions in the seminars. The seminar paper/dissertation constitutes a crucial part of the teaching programme, as it contributes significantly to the development of the research potential of the students. Appendix III (Tables A, B, C & D) provides the list of seminar papers/dissertation presented by the students during the current

academic year.

AWARDS / MEDALS

A student from MPS programme, whose overall performance is adjudged to be the best, is awarded the Dr. C. Chandrasekaran Gold Medal.

A student each from DHPE and PGDCH programmes, whose overall performance adjudged to be the best, are awarded the IIPS Gold Medal.

A student, whose overall performance is adjudged to be the best in the MPS (Distance Learning) programme, is awarded the Dr. K. Srinivasan Gold Medal.

A student, whose overall performance is adjudged to be the best in the DPS (Distance Learning) programme is awarded the IIPS Gold Medal.

A student whose overall performance is adjudged to be the best in the M. Phil programme is awarded IIPS gold medal. The student adjudged as the second best will receive IIPS silver medal.

A student whose M. Phil/Ph.D thesis, adjudged to be the best, is awarded the Dr. P.N. Mari Bhat Gold Medal. This award has been instituted in memory of the late Prof. P.N. Mari Bhat by his parents.

A student whose overall performance is adjudged to be the best in the MA / M.Sc. programme is awarded the Prof. Asha A. Bhende Gold Medal. This medal has been instituted in memory of the late Prof. Asha A. Bhende by the Institute of Health Management, Pachod (IHMP).

A student from MPS programme, whose seminar

paper, rated as the best, is awarded the Dr. J.R. Rele award. This award is based on the Seminar paper's content; and the student's presentation and defence skill, while presenting the paper at the 'IIPS Student – Faculty Seminar'.

Silver medals (IIPS) are awarded to students whose overall performance is ranked as the second best, in the respective programmes – MA / M.Sc., MPS, DHPE, DPS (Distance Learning) and MPS (Distance Learning).

SHORT - TERM PROGRAMMES

In addition to the above, the Institute conducts short-term training courses on request. The following two short-term training programmes were conducted during the academic year 2012-13

“Demography, Gender and Reproductive Health” was organized during 08th July to 04th August, 2012. Prof. F. Ram, Director & Senior Professor, IIPS, inaugurated the training programme on 09th July, 2012. Dr. Kristina Myrvold, Director, Nordic Centre in India (NCI) and Ms. Christabel Royan, Programme Manager, NCI attended the inaugural function. There were 29 participants from different Nordic countries (Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Finland and Iceland). The basic objective of the training programme was to create awareness in the area of Demography, Gender and Reproductive Health and to enable the trainees to understand the real life situation in India. The training programme consisted of class room sessions, assignments, presentations and

field visits. The participants visited two NGOs namely FPAI and CSSC, Bandra as well as two slums located in Dharavi and Mankhurd, to understand the life situations of people who are staying in those areas. The participants also visited IHMP (Pachod) and Aurangabad for 3 days and explored the community health setup in rural India.



Population and Development Course for participants from Bhutan commenced on 1st October, 2012 and ended on 12th October, 2012. Prof. F. Ram, Director, IIPS inaugurated the training programme. This training programme was sponsored by Gross National Happiness Commission (GNHC) of Bhutan. There were 11 participants in the programme.

The basic objective of the training programme was to create awareness and to enable the trainees to develop applications in real life situations. The training programme consisted of class room sessions, practical sessions and computer lab exercises. Age-sex structure of population, concepts, definition and measures of fertility, mortality, morbidity and migration, Population Projections and Statistical packages such as

SPECTRUM and MORTPAK were the main topics covered in this training programme.



Study Visit of Scholars from Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK)

A delegation of academic visitors from the Population Institute of Kim IL Sung University, Pyongyang, Korea visited the institute during 1st to 6th Nov 2012. They had interactions with Director and faculty members on various aspects of developing teaching and research programmes in demography.

1. WORLD POPULATION DAY

Observance of "World Population Day" on 11th July every year is one of the important activities of the Institute. This year it was observed at the Institute by organizing a half-day symposium on the theme of "Abortion: Pro-choice or Pro-life" on 11th July 2012.

Prof. F. Ram, Director of IIPS, emphasized the relevance of the World Population Day and spoke on important population issues. The Ph.D. scholars who participated in the debate on the theme include Mr. Rajan Kumar Gupt, Ms. Garima Dutta, Ms. Shraboni Patra, Mr. Mayank Prakash, Ms. Kshipra Jain and Mr. Castor Rasmussen. Faculty, staff and students attended the programme.

As part of the celebration of World Populations Day, the faculty members visited various colleges in Mumbai and delivered lectures on population issues during 2nd to 11th July, 2012.

In addition, an essay writing competition was organized at the Institute on July 9th 2012 for students from colleges in Mumbai and also for students of the institute. The topic of the essay for the college students was "Population of India: Asset or Burden?" and the Ph.D. students were asked to write an essay on "Urban Housing in India". On 11th July 2012, the winners of essay writing competition were awarded cash prizes and certificates.

The World Population Day activity was coordinated by Dr. Chander Shekhar, Dr. Abhishek Singh and Mr. Prakash H. Fulpagare.

2. PROFESSOR ASHA A. BHENDE MEMORIAL LECTURE

The Second Professor Asha A. Bhende Memorial Lecture was held at IIPS on 20th April, 2013. Dr. Indira Jaising, Additional Solicitor General of India delivered the lecture on “Freedom to marry a person of your choice: Interference from KHAP Panchayats?” The memorial lecture was instituted by Ashish Gram Rachana Trust, Pachod in memory of its former chairperson, Prof. Bhende, who was also a Professor of IIPS.

Dr. Indira Jaising, using the available evidences from various resources and studies, elaborated on the present social and cultural scenario in India and how the freedom of individuals being curtailed.

3. DR. C. CHANDRASEKARAN MEMORIAL LECTURE

The eleventh Dr. C. Chandrasekaran Memorial Lecture was held at IIPS on 8th November, 2012. Dr. Arvind Panagariya delivered the lecture on “The Child Malnutrition Indicator for India: With a Grain of Salt”. Dr. Arvind Panagariya is Professor of Economics and Jagdish Bhagwati Professor of Indian Political Economy at Columbia University, USA and an ex-Chief Economist at the Asian Development Bank.

Dr. Panagariya argued in his presentation that the widely held belief in India about high level of malnutrition among children fails to stand up to close empirical scrutiny and in fact is a myth. According to him, this is mainly because of faulty methodology adopted by researchers. He also felt that the common impression that India has not made much progress in child nutrition, despite economic progress, is also not true.

4. DR. P.N. MARI BHAT MEMORIAL LECTURE

Fifth Professor P.N. Mari Bhat Memorial Lecture was held at IIPS on 16th January, 2013. Professor John Cleland from London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine, U. K. delivered the lecture on “Does Europe’s Second Demographic Transition have any Relevance for India?”. Prof. F. Ram, Director, IIPS, chaired the session.

5. NATIONAL SEMINARS

A. National Seminar

National Seminar on Population Health and Environment was organized by IIPS in collaboration with Indian Institute of Forest Management, Bhopal during 21-23 March, 2013. Focus of the seminar was to recognize the interconnectedness between people and their environment. Around 150 papers were presented in three plenary sessions, 19 oral and two poster sessions. First plenary session was

on Health and Development in India, second dealt with Natural Resources and Environment and third was on Health and Development in Madhya Pradesh. The participants include established scholars to young students from various disciplinary backgrounds.

XI. LIBRARY

The International Institute for Population Sciences Library has a focused collection of resources taking into consideration the course contents and research needs of the Institute. It holds about 81320 books, 14824 bound volumes of periodicals, 16,513 Reprints and 500 audio-visual materials and subscribes to over 200 journals supplemented with online access, more than 125 journals received in the library by the way of gift and exchange. More than 24000 research articles from the core journals and edited books have been indexed and made available through OPAC. The library has the collection on population studies and relevant subjects like, religion, psychology, sociology, statistics, economics, public administration, education, mathematics, anthropology, public health, geography etc. The library provides a host of information services to its users, like Current Awareness, New Additions, Selective Dissemination of Information, Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC), Document Delivery Service, Photocopy facilities, Reference Service, Bibliographic service, metadata interpolation and so on.

The IIPS Library is fully computerized system. Library serves to the faculty, students, research scholars and institutional members. The library has a special collection of Census of India volumes of 1982-1941 digitized in PDF which provides full text access on the campus. The library provides access to the several databases like JSTOR, SCIEDIRECT (social science collection), SCOPUS, INDIASTAT. The library also subscribes

selected journals of, Springer, Sage, Wiley, Taylor & Francis, Cambridge etc. through online mode. The library is accessible through www.iipsindia.org for all.

Mr. D.D. Mestri is In-Charge of the library.

XII. INFORMATION, COMMUNICATION AND TECHNOLOGY UNIT

The ICT Unit of the institute which was till recently known as the Computer and Data Centre is well equipped with the latest Pentium IV and higher generation computers and statistical software required for data analysis. The Unit has one main classroom/lab room with 42 computers with three LCD projectors, another small class room/lab with capacity of 16 computers and LCD. Computer classes for MPS, MA/MSc, M.Phil and short term courses are held in these labs. The software packages installed are IBM SPSS Version 20, STATA Version 10, GIS Version 10, ML Win, Atlas Ti, Spectrum, Mortpak, and Endnote. All the computers are configured for internet access and connected by Local Area Network. The ICT Unit has network attached storage (Nasstor) server which stores data from Census, National Family Health Survey, District Level Household Survey etc. and also providing the internal email facility to the institute. Wireless internet facilities have been established and made available to the students in the hostels and library. There are a total 260 desktop computers and eight servers in the Institute.

The data set of Census of 1991 and 2001, National Family Health Survey I, II and III, District Level Household Survey I, II and III, Demographic

Health Survey (DHS) and National Sample Survey (NSS) data are available to researchers. Data sets from GATS, Youth, LASI and SAGE projects are also provided to researchers who request these data sets. An E-book in the CD-ROM media containing the full papers of DPS/MPS/M.Phil students' seminar has been prepared, and six e-books on the topic related to the reproductive health, child and maternal mortality are also prepared. ICT unit is maintaining IIPS website. ICT unit is in the process of making website bilingual (English-Hindi). Steps have been initiated to start E-Governance in the institute to cover the functioning of the various departments of the institute including Accounts and Administration.

Prof. M Guruswamy and Prof. Sayeed Unisa were in-charge of ICT Unit.

XIII. PUBLICATION UNIT

IIPS has a well established publication unit. Periodically IIPS publishes Newsletters, Research Briefs and Working papers.

a. IIPS Newsletter

The Institute brings out Newsletters, which publish information about various ongoing activities of the Institute. Two issues of IIPS Newsletters covering four numbers were printed during the academic year, 2012-13.

Dr. T.V. Sekher and Dr. Manoj Alagarajan are the Editors of IIPS Newsletter.

b. IIPS Research Brief Series

The 'Research Brief Series' is a new initiative of the Institute started in 2007, to provide an opportunity to the faculty, Ph.D. students and visiting fellows to quickly disseminate the important findings of their research studies before they are published as a research report or in a scientific journal. So far, 14 research briefs were published under this series.

Dr. T.V. Sekher and Dr. Manoj Alagarajan are the Editors of IIPS Research Brief Series.

c. IIPS Working Paper Series

The 'Working Paper Series' is a new initiative started during 2009-10. Its main objective is to disseminate new research ideas, theoretical development and methodological insights initiated by IIPS to the national and international community as quickly as possible. The papers published under this series are peer-reviewed by two external experts working in the areas of Population, Health and Development. So far, 8 working papers were published.

Dr. T.V. Sekher is the Editor of IIPS working paper series.

XIV. DEMOGRAPHY INDIA JOURNAL

The professional Journal of Indian Association for the Study of Population (IASP) is presently managed at IIPS. Prof. F. Ram is the Chief Editor of the Journal since 2011. This long standing journal publishes peer reviewed articles and book

reviews, focusing on demographic and health issues and more specifically on Indian demography. The two issues brought out each year contain about 25 articles, book reviews and presidential address of IASP conferences and Dr. George Simmons memorial lectures. The journal is subscribed by the universities and research centers both in India and abroad, apart from the members of IASP. Dr. T. V. Sekher is the Managing Editor of the Journal.

XV. PLACEMENT CELL

In order to help the graduating students to find suitable job opportunities, a Placement Cell was established at the Institute in 2010. This Cell contacts various organizations / institutes working in the field of population, health and related areas and convey the CVs and information about the passing out students.

The Cell also facilitates conducting the campus interviews for organizations interested in recruiting from IIPS. This provides a unique opportunity for the employers and students to interact each other for the benefit of both.

XVI. HOSTEL FACILITY

The teaching and training programme at the Institute are fully residential. The Institute has two hostels. All the rooms are self contained, well furnished and having adequate living and working space. There are 24 air conditioned rooms at par with International standards with television with cable facilities and computers with the internet to

accommodate international students and guests of the institute. A separate kitchenette is available for the use of international students/ researchers.

There is a hostel mess run on no- loss no- profit basis by a committee consisting of student representatives, hostel staff and hostel warden. A separate hall having computers with internet is provided for students' use. A number of washing machines and LCD televisions are also provided exclusively for students' use in hostels. Indoor and outdoor game facilities and a well equipped gymnasium are also available.

Dr. S. K. Mohanty is the Hostel Warden.
