Ram, Director & Senior Professor, highlighted the issues while Prof. Yesudian, Senior Professor Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai and Prof. R. B. Bhagat, Professor and Head, Department of Migration and Urbanization, IIPS delivered specific topics and discussed with audience about population trends and related issues. Following the lecture, prizes were distributed to the winning candidates of inter-collegiate Essay Competition. Prof. H. Lhungdim, Dr. Dipti Govil and Dr. Manas Pradhan organised the event.

Swachh Bharata Abhiyan

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Unintended Pregnancy and Abortion in India (UPAI)-Activities

1. Pre-Test

The pre-test workshop for Unintended Pregnancy and Abortion in India (UPAI) study was conducted between 2 July 2014 to 8 July 2014 at Jaipur, India. The main objective of the pre-test workshop was to test the tools to ensure smooth field procedures prior to the actual surveys being implemented. Three day Class room training of investigators was followed by 3 days of field work. UPAI coordinators from IIPS and the Guttmacher team (Dr Ann More, Dr Jennifer Frost, Dr Rubina Hussain, Dr Aparna Sundaraman and Ms Shveta Kalyanwalla) in addition to resource persons Dr. Sushanta Banerjee and Dr. Dinesh Aggrawal conducted the training. The Director IIPS, Prof F. Ram, inaugurated the workshop and highlighted the importance of this study and its main objectives as well as highlighting the aim of pre-test. 14 Research investigators from different states namely Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh participated in this workshop.

2. Steering Committee

The first **Steering Committee meeting** was held on 27th August 2014 in Nirman Bhawan ministry of health & family welfare, New Delhi. The committee which was chaired by Shri C. K. Mishra, Additional Secretary and Mission Director (National Health Mission). The main objective of the meeting was to appraise the ongoing activities of the UPAI study and seek inputs from the planning perspective.





Workshop on "GIS and its Application"

The workshop on 'GIS' and its application was held during 16-22, July 2014. IIPS organized by Population –Environment-Human Settlement Priest (Pop-Envis). The workshop aims to highlight the importance of GIS, its applications in various fields. A total of 44 students from M.Sc., M.Phil., Ph.D. with various background ranging from mathematics, statistics, geography, social sciences and other backgrounds of different academic institutes in Mumbai, participated in the workshop.

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National Family Health Survey-4 Activities

Given below are the major accomplishments under this project during July to December 2014:

- Mapping and House Hold listing TOT: This TOT was organized at Youth Centre, Kharghar, Navi Mumbai from 7th July 2014 to 9th July 2014 for 17 first phase states.
- 2. **Main TOT:** This TOT was organized at Puri from 18th August 2014 to 10th September 2014 for 17 first phase states.
- 3. HIV Committee meeting: This meeting was organized at NARI, Pune on 26th August 2014 after visiting various laboratories selected for HIV testing to discuss the assessment reports of five laboratories selected for HIV testing under NFHS-4 program. The meeting was attended by IIPS faculty coordinators, NARI Director and faculties and representative from ICF and NACO.
- Meeting with Field Agencies: A meeting with all Field Agencies was organized at IIIPS, Mumbai on 22nd September 2014 to assess the progress of Mapping and House Hold Listing activities going on in 17 first phase states.
- Refresher Training for Mapping and House Hold List: This training was organized at IIIPS, Mumbai from 8th October 2014 to 10th October 2014.
- Main TOT: Another Main TOT was organized at IIPS Mumbai from 27th October 2014 to 3rd November 2014.

7. HIV Committee Meeting: A meeting was



organized on 5th November 2014 at IIPS, Mumabi with NACO, NARI, Pune, MoHF and all the HIV testing laboratories selected for HIV testing to smoothen the transfer of DBS from field agencies to testing laboratories for HIV.

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Longitudinal Aging Study in India (LASI) Activities

1. Expert Meeting -LASI Economic Sections

An expert Group meeting was conducted to discuss the economic sections of LASI instrument. Prof. Jinkook Lee, USC and Prof. S. Madheswaran, ISEC were invited for one day meeting on 20 October, 2014. The economic sections were discussed in detail and all the suggestions and feedback from the experts were incorporated in the economic questionnaire of LASI instrument.





2. LASI Man Wave (2014-19) : Pre-Test-I

LASI main wave Pretest-I was conducted in November, 2014 in the selected villages and urban wards in the neighborhoods of Mumbai city. The objective of this pretest-I is to test and understand the validity and feasibility revised economic sections including Household Income, Consumption, Assets & Debts, Roster and Community survey on the field. The training was held during 10-18 November, 2014 at IIPS and the pretest-I field work was conducted during 18-21 November, 2014 in the neighbourhoods of Mumbai city.

In order to gain experience and to have better insights into the implementation of survey protocols across different types of localities/areas, three different types of secondary sampling units (SSUs) were chosen for field practice-2 rural and 1 urban (slum)/SSU which are situated in Panvel taluka. Both in Rural and urban setting, both households and individual schedules were carried out. Also community survey was conducted by the supervisors' one each at the village and ward (Urban) level. Total 12 investigators teams were recruited and trained and assigned them into three teams, 1team for each SSU. In 4 days of field work, total 107 Household interviews and 186 individual interviews were covered. Overall the LASI pretest-I was successfully implemented.

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IIPS-Kusuma Foundation Research Fellowship 4rd Training Workshop (Module-4)

IIPS-Kusuma The fourth training workshop of Foundation related to research methodology entitled "Principles of Scientific Writing and Communication" was successfully completed during 21-25 July, 2014. Prof. Balram Paswan and Dr. Manas Ranjan Pradhan were the course instructors of this Module. The main objective of this module was to gets introduce the fellows to various types of scientific writings, key principles of scientific writing, developing the scientific abstract, typical structure of a research paper, and scientific communication. It is expected that the knowledge of these essential principles would help



you in writing scientific research papers and in communication for publication.

The Hindi Week was observed at the Institute during 15-19 September 2014. On this occasion, various programmes and competitions like Shuddha Lekhan Pratiyogita, Anuwad Pratiyogita, Aashubhashan Pratiyogita, Antakshari Pratiyogita and Kavi Sammelan were organised for the staff and students of the Institute. 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International Seminar On

"Assisted Reproductive Technologies in Northern and Southern Countries: Issues, Challenges and the Future"

IIPS, Mumbai, 30-31 October, 2014

The International Seminar on "Assisted Reproductive Technologies in Northern and Southern Countries: issues, challenges and the future" has been hold in Mumbai, at IIPS, during 30-31 October 2014. This seminar was coorganised by the Institut National d'Etudes Démographiques (INED, Paris, France), the International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS, Mumbai, India), the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA, Delhi, India) and the Centre de Population et de Développement (CEPED, Paris, France).



During the two day seminar five sessions were organised and 18 presentations were made by senior researchers from nine countries. Participants of this seminar had already published several papers and books on ART issues, and some of them were ART experts, including a Director of an infertility clinic, a delegate from Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), a Director of a surrogacy agency and a delegate of an Indian women's group. These exciting presentations represented different disciplines (anthropology, medicine, law, sociology, public health, demography) and dealt with nine different countries and regions.

** Government of India Fellowships @ ` 16,000/- per month for 1st and 2nd years and ` 18,000/- per month for 3rd year respectively available for the Indian students who have qualified NET for Lectureship only in population or its inter-disciplinary subjects conducted by the UGC. Such Ph.D. fellowship also carries a contingency grant of ` 10,000/- per year for the first two years and ` 20,500/- for the third year. However the candidates, without NET qualification shall be given fellowship @ ` 12,000/- per month for the 1st and 2nd years, and ` 14,000/- per month for the 3rd year, with a contingency grant of ` 10,000/- per year. Number of seats will be as per the availability of fellowships at the time of admission. In addition, UGC-JRF and other fellowship holders will also be considered for admission as per availability of seats.

Eligible foreign students may apply, provided they secure funds from appropriate agencies. Foreign candidates may apply for the Government of India Post Doctoral Fellowship (PDF) for consideration.
