4. DPR/General issues

4.1. Regular PMGSY

- Proposal has not been received as per NRRDA letter No. H-11020/2/05-Tech dated 10.01.2013. MP1, MP2, MP3 formats and SLSC approval needs to be submitted by the State.
- Average cost is on higher side when compared to previous sanctions.
- Sample DPRs received on 06.01.2018 and under scrutiny.
- Roads where the average cost/km is more than 70 Lakhs/Km, needs to verify by the State including site verification by Senior officers of the State. (10 roads in Visakhapatnam and 1 road in Vizianagaram district).
- Clear L & X sections have not been attached with the DPR. Certain L and X section drawings in A4 size and not legible. Earth work quantities, CDs, Protective works proposed in the DPRs are not duly justified with reference to L/S and C/S drawings.
- 6.00 m top width only permitted for link roads as per the recommendation of Expert Committee report. However, State has proposed 7.50 m top width. The additional cost should come from State share or the DPRs should be revised.
- State has not proposed any roads using Fly Ash.
- State should get appropriate number of samples tested for stabilization of base and sub base courses for determining the dose of stabilizer for achieving the required UCS strength through laboratories and results should be attached with the DPR.
- State should ensure that all the DPRs of LWE area of 100-249, pavements have been designed with Cement Treated Sub base and bases as per IRC SP:72-2015.
- Higher number of CD works, Protective works and Pucca side drain proposed and needs to be justified with L/S and C/S drawings.
- Traffic sign board are on higher side and needs to be rationalised.
- Joint Inspection report of STA/CE/SE for bridge site as per format prescribed by NRRDA has not been provided.

4.2. DPR Issues (RCPLWE)

- Sample DPRs received on 06.01.2018 and under scrutiny.
- Average cost/Km is on higher side when compared to previous sanction.
- All the roads proposed with 3.75 m carriageway width with T4 traffic category.

- 5% of total length in IRC Accredited materials/Technologies as per new technology initiatives guidelines to be proposed.

 State has not proposed any roads using Fly Ash/Steel slag
