A Meeting of the Pre- Empowered Committee to consider the proposal of PMGSY (Batch II 2018-19) Left Out Bridges on roads sanctioned prior to April 2011 for the State of Bihar was held in the Chamber of Joint Secretary (RC) on 4th December, 2018.

3. <u>Issues Discussed and decisions taken:</u>

- The average cost of the proposal was a bit on the higher side. The state was asked to relook into the cost of proposals.
- Substructure and foundation cost seem to be on higher and need special checking and redesign.
- Hydraulic data, Catchment Area (CA) calculation etc are missing in the DPR. CA must be calculated using survey or top sheet.
- The charges for the preparation of DPR and all types of investigations (Soil, Hydraulic, Survey etc.) should not be more than 1% of project cost.
- The State submitted that for Bihar it is 0.6% of the project cost.
- It was communicated to the state that 4951 Km works was pending with the State which was to be expedited.
- The State was also directed to send the proposals for dropping of roads within 1 week.
- State was also asked to analyse 1345Kms entered in the miscellaneous head in OMMAS.
- The slow progress in award of works was also raised as a point of concern.
- With respect to quality the following issues were of concern.
- 1. 44.58% of the ongoing packages inspected by SQMs did not have package labs.
- 2. 834 works have not been inspected even once by SQMs and payment of more than Rs. 1 lakh have been made in 150 works.
- 3. Works of 23.17% of contractors have not been examined even once by NQMs.
- 4. ATRs of 45 completed and 173 ongoing works are pending with the State. It was communicated to the State that EC meeting would not be held unless these ATRs are liquidated.
- Dissatisfaction was expressed on the issue of low quality of works. The State was asked to appoint a regular SQC.
- Observations will be done by December raised for the Balance Sheets.
- 700 final bills are pending closure.
