2. Dir (Tech.) presented the proposals sent by the State as under:

The state representative informed that 181 proposals which were submitted to STA, Patna in January has not yet been scrutinized by the STA. On further discussions it was suggested that the proposals may be submitted online to the STA and fees to STA should be enhanced.

The State confirmed that this is the last batch for (100-249) habitations in which 314 habitations of 100-249 category have been proposed and no more habitations are left for submission of proposals. One batch of left out bridges is only remaining to be submitted.

NRRDA presented the details of unconnected eligible and sanctioned habitations of 250 and above population categories as under:

With regard to updation of data on OMMAS the State was requested to update data regarding:

- i. Sanctioned habitations
- ii. Habitations connected
- iii. Habitations incidentally connected.

It was also agreed that the data updation will be completed before the Empowered Committee Meeting.

#### General and DPR Issues:

- Sample DPRs not yet received from State for scrutiny. DPRs have not been received in time.
- State has proposed roads in LWE areas. Pavements should be designed with Cement Treated Sub base and Cement Treated base (or treated with locally available materials/Naturally occurring Materials/Slag/Fly Ash etc) with surface dressing using Cold Mix/Waste Plastic or Stage construction (Stage A and Stage B) with not more than T3 traffic as per Ministry's advisory No.NRRDA/P017(24)/2/2016-Tech dated 23.11.2016. State has contented that PMC was allowed for CG. So it should be allowed for Bihar as well. Pre-EC agreed to it. WMM should be allowed only if plants are available. This should be responsibility of the concerned PIUs.
- State has proposed 108 roads with 3.75 m in LWE area. It should be proposed 3 m width as per Ministry's advisory dated 23.11.2016.
- The Average Provision for CC pavement is very high. Districts which are proposed CC roads of more than 15% of total proposed length should be got

verified and CC length needs to be reduced accordingly.

- State has not proposed any roads using Fly ash, Pond ash, Bottom ash and Cement treated sub base/bases.
- Proforma C have not been uploaded on OMMAS for 9 roads.

#### 4. Maintenance issues:

- State has proposed maintenance cost of 6.84 % which was agreed to by the EC.
  The State has yet not credited funds to SRRDA for Maintenance in the present
  year; it was conveyed to the State that this is a matter of critical observation by
  IFD during fund release.
- Bihar has made a provision of 176 crores (centre +state)under post 5 years maintenance. However it was seen that the State needs atleast 500 crores for past years maintenance. State agreed to make the provision.
- It was conveyed to the state that post 5 year data should be uploaded on OMMAS. Suggestion was made for provisioning uploading of post 10 year data also on OMMAS.

#### 5. R&D Technology:

8 roads under Mechanical Stabilization technology (2.92 Km) should be converted to paneled CC.

#### 6. Quality Issues:

- It was seen that there are 1312 unawarded projects including 841 of 2017-18, 325 of 2016-17 and 146 of 2013-14.
- It was seen that 144 projects of 2016-17 have been awarded by not uploaded on OMMAS.
- 511 packages have been inspected by SQMs where labs were not established.
   This State was told that this figure should be brought to zero.
- It was seen that 697 works were not inspected even once by SQM where payments of more than Rs. 1 lakh have been made. State was told to send SQM on urgent priority basis in the case of 13 completed works.
- Works of 690 contractors have not been inspected by NQMs even once.
- 59 ATRs of completed works and 271 ATRs of ongoing works are pending. State was asked to resolve 154 ATRs of SRI category first.
- 'U' grading is not above the national targets in all cases. 43.1% 'U' grading in maintenance works is a cause of concern for the state since the expenditure on maintenance was 95% during 2017-18. The State was asked to conduct a review of the GMs and initiate action. The State was also asked to conduct Maintenance workshops for PIUs.
- An analysis of the 'U' grading shows that 26% of the cases are due to Geometrics (improper width of road ways) and 28% due to Base Course (improper gradation) and 20% non-functioning of the Labs.

#### 7. Misc. Decisions taken in the Pre-EC:

The STA scrutiny of all proposals should be completed and updated proposal for

all 314 habitations should be sent to NRRDA with DPRs latest by  $15^{\rm th}$  April, 2018 . • The Empowered Committee meeting was tentatively scheduled on  $23^{\rm rd}$  April.
