3. Issues discussed and decisions taken

- The State needs to update the habitation data on OMMAS before the Empowered Committee Meeting.
- Rate of sub grade soil with CBR of more than 10 is slightly higher than the rate of soil having CBR of 5 to 6. State can use the material of CBR 10 for sub grade construction wherever 10 CBR material is available. Once this soil is used, 50% of GSB cost will reduce. In this regard State had already justified in the previous EC held on 4/9/2018 for Batch II of PMGSY-1 and Batch-I of PMGSY-II (2018-19)In this regard, state has submitted in their compliance that availability of material of 10 CBR is scarce, only sufficient for shoulder construction that to adjacent to grade-III of 75 MM. Therefore, need for 300 MM sub grade has been made 5-6 CBR material.
- Concern was expressed over the slow rate of physical progress by the state. State said that 700 km of works are still unawarded for works in LWE districts and nomination facility has not worked out in these cases. The state requested for the removal of PreQ for these works like the PWD for this particular unawarded 700km in LWE areas. State was asked to submit a proposal for the same to the Ministry.
- One ATR of more than 5 years for a completed work to be liquidated by the state before the EC meeting.
- Committee asked NRIDA to liquidate One ATR of more than 3 years of ongoing works.
- The status for development of the Roster App for assigning NQM inspections of the contractors was asked by the JS(RC) considering only 63% contractor inspections at National Level. It was informed that the sample launch of the App would be done within October.
- 25 completed works are pending financial closure for more than 6 months. State requested extension and was asked to send a request citing reasons for the delay.
- State was asked to submit the UC for the funds released under Swacchata Action Plan.
- Programme Division was asked to write a letter to the state requesting for change of agency for
 execution of RCPLWE giving a comparative statement of the status of tenders of RCPLWE and
 Regular PMGSY for the past one year.
