

# MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PRE-EMPOWERED COMMITTEE HELD ON 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2018 TO CONSIDER PROJECT PROPOSALS SUBMITTED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF CHHATTISGARH FOR ROAD CONNECTIVITY OF LWE HABITATIONS (100-249) UNDER PRADHAN MANTRI GRAM SADAK YOJANA (PMGSY)

A Meeting of the Pre-Empowered Committee was held under the Chairpersonship of Joint Secretary (RC), Ministry of Rural Development on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2018 to discuss the proposals submitted by the State of Chhattisgarh for road connectivity of LWE habitations (100-249) under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) (Batch-I, 2017-18). ### DPR/General Issues

- The State has not yet provided sample DPRs to NRRDA for scrutiny.
- · Certain roads which are included in the instant proposal also require

bridges. But, the State Government has not proposed any bridge, which is against the programme guidelines. The State representative informed that the DPRs could not be prepared due bon-responsive tenders. The State was asked to come with all those details at the time of EC meeting.

- The State intimated work on 100 more DPRs is underway and shall be ready well before the EC meeting.
- The State Government is yet to submit the new SoR, which is inclusive of GST to NRRDA for approval.
- While the State was asked to go ahead with OGPC Seal coat, in certain blocks which are not very affected by naxal violence, the State was asked to explore feasibility of surface of dressing to the extent of 25 to 35%.
- The State was asked to use the local material upto the extent possible.
- Pavements should be designed with Cement Treated Sub base and Cement Treated base (or treated with locally available materials/Naturally occurring Materials/Slag/Fly Ash etc) with surface dressing using Cold Mix/Waste Plastic or Stage construction (Stage A & Stage B) with not more than T3 traffic as per Ministry's advisory no. NRRDA/PO17 (24)/2/2016-Tech dated 23.11.2016.
- Joint inspection reports for bridge sites for LSBs have not been provided. Site suitability for bridges is not being examined. The State was advised to follow proper process during design.
- Proforma C has not been uploaded for 206 works.
- Images have not been uploaded for 358 works.

## 4. Quality Issue

- State representative intimated that the plastic waste material shall also be used in construction of some roads.
- Percentage of R&D roads with respect of total length has been proposed to the tune 6.67%, which should be increased to 15%.
- There was mismatch in the figures as on OMMAS vis-a-vis reported by the State relating to works still to be awarded. The same is required to be reconciled.
- There are 44 ongoing works which have not been inspected by SQM even once.
- 3 ATRs are more than 3 years old. State was advised to liquidate all ATRs of more than 6 months' period immediately.

### 5. Financial issues

i. There were again mismatch in the figures presented by Director (F&A) vis-à-vis the figures claimed by the State

Government representatives. JS (RC) desired that the officials in NRRDA should speak to State representatives before finalization of presentation to avoid misrepresentation of facts and figures.

### 6. Recommendation of the Committee

- i. List of sample DPRs to be indicated by NRRDA today, i.e. on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2018.
  ii. The new SoR should be finalized by Monday i.e. 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2018.
  iii. DPRs to be submitted by the State to NRRDA for scrutiny by 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2018.
- iv. The meeting of the Empowered Committee has been scheduled on 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 at 11 am.
