State Officials reported that balance proposals of 25 habitations in the category of 250+ would be submitted within 2 weeks time. State officials also informed that they have completed DRRP for PMGSY-II & would be submitting entire DRRP proposals after due approval of SLSC. State was asked to submit DRPs of PMGSY-II, shortly.

3. DPR issues:

- i. Transect walk photographs, Summary and Grama Sabha approval not attached in DPRs.
- ii. The cost of scarifying existing damaged BT surface rate Rs. 843 is on very high side.

 Needs to be verified by the State.
- iii. State should certify that these proposed works have not been sanctioned by DoNER/other state schemes.
- iv. Average cost is on higher side when compared to previous sanction particularly in South Garo and West Garo districts in complete construction, which is due to the provisions of higher Protection works and Pucca drain. Needs to be justified with L and X section drawings.
- v. The quantity of earthwork proposed for new connectivity is seems to be on higher side. Needs to be rationalised.
- vi. In cross section drawings road top/finished levels needs to be indicated. Super elevation/Curver designs are missing in DPRs.
- vii. Credit for hard rock cutting needs to be included in DPRs for new connectivity works.
- viii. Utility shifting charges should come from the State share.
 - ix. Joint Inspection report of STA/CE/SE for bridge site as per format prescribed by NRIDA has not been provided.

4. Physical Progress:

Against the target of 400 km, only 35 km has been completed till date. State was asked to pick up the pace of construction.

5. F & A Issues:

State has not yet submitted balance sheet for the year 2017-18.
