Minutes of the meeting of Pre-Empowered Committee held on 8th January 2018 to discuss proposals of the State of Rajasthan under PMGSY-II.

State: Rajasthan

A meeting of Pre-Empowered Committee was held on 8th January 2018 at 4:30 PM under the chairpersonship of Joint Secretary (RC) to discuss the proposals submitted by the State of Rajasthan under PMGSY-II (Batch-II, 2017-18). List of participants is given below:

2. **Current Proposals:** Details of proposals discussed by the Pre-Empowered Committee for the State of Rajasthan under regular PMGSY-II (Batch-II, 2017-18) are as under:

3. **Average cost:**

The Additional Secretary and Chief Engineer informed that based on the scrutiny of DPRs by NRRDA the proposals have been corrected and the correct average cost of DPRs is Rs 34 crore / km (including GST). The committee observed that it is in order and advised the state to correct the cost on OMMAS before Empowered Committee Meeting.

4. **R&D Technology:**

State has not proposed roads leading to 5% of total road length using new materials/technology Accredited by IRC.

5. **Maintenance Cost :**

The State was advised to make a provision of about 7% of the construction cost towards 5 year routine maintenance and above 15% of the construction cost towards renewal coat after 5 years.

6. Finance & Account issues:

Entries for maintenance fund have only been made upto September, 2017, which needs to be updated.

7. DPR Issues:

- i. Corrected cost of DPRs has not been submitted by the State.
- ii. Provision of dismantling of existing CC road and laying new CC with provisions of subbase and base course are not justified. An overlay of 125mm panelled CC may be proposed.
- iii. Provision of paved shoulder included in DPR is not justified.
- iv. As informed by the State during the meeting, the corrected cost should be uploaded on OMMAS.
- v. As agreed by the state atleast 5% of the total road length should be proposed using IRC accredited materials / Technologies and accordingly uploaded on OMMAS.

8. After discussing the proposals in detail, subject to the compliance of the above observations, the Pre-Empowered Committee recommended 12 road works of 108.20 km road length, amounting to Rs40.66 crore of the State of Rajasthan.
