The State has requested permission for submitting the leftover balance of PMGSY-I under upgradation category.

#### 3. General and DPR Issues:

- Average cost has increased substantially from 45.22 to 2017-18 and 61.77 in present proposals. State responded
  that these proposals based on 2017-18 SOR and also includes GST. In addition, 4 districts (Hilly & delta
  regions) are increasing to the cost as these districts have difficult terrain and soil type.
- Roads proposed are BT roads. Pre EC suggested State may take up some roads in surface dressing.
- State has provided corrected cost of 50 roads in 4 districts where the sample DPRs have been verified at NRRDA. Remaining roads no corrections made as per the observations of NRRDA. State has reduced Rs. 3.70 Crores in 30 roads. State responded that balance roads are well within cost and State said that the area is delta region and wherever possible mechanical stabilization will be done using flyash.
- 300 mm thick gravel with a cost of Rs. 1,290/Cum to a width of 4.05 m over existing BT road has been
  provided which is not logical (TN09267). Also 100 mm thickness GSB layer also proposed over 300 mm
  thickness Gravel. Gravel provision needs to be deleted. State agreed that mechanical stabilization will be done
  with flyash.
- As the road is proposed under up-gradation and the existing road is damaged BT surface with less than T5
  category traffic, two layer WBM should be proposed as per Clause 2.2.3 (i) of IRC SP:72-2015. State has been
  asked to verify and propose accordingly.
- Credit has not been given to the exiting available crust.
- Test results indicating OMC, MDD, LL, PI and CBR for GSB materials has not been attached with the DPR which was agreed to by the State.
- Most of existing CD works proposed for replacement. From photographs it can be observed that cleaning of CD structures and repairs to Parapet only are required (TN1011, TN21169 & TN09267). State has rectified this in the DPRs.
- Invariably Cement concrete protective works have been proposed in many of the road works and height
  provided in the DPR do not match with the X-Section drawings and photographs. Gabion type retaining wall
  may be proposed for certain works instead of CC protective works. This has been proposed in delta region
  roads as stones are not available here.
- State should verify the DPRs including site inspection by the CE/SE level officers where the average cost is
  more than Rs. 80 Lakhs/Km and rationalized. (28 cases). State agreed to this suggestion.
- Emulsion rate (SS1) provided in the DPR is Rs. 63,300/MT which seems to be on higher side. Needs to be
  verified by the State. Present cost is 75000 with GST as confirmed by the State. State was asked to re-verify
  this.
- Sample Bridge DPRs needs to be scrutinised at NRRDA. State will send DPRs within 10 days.

#### 4. Maintenance issues:

Maintenance costs proposed were agreed to by the PreEC.

## 5. R&D Technology:

- 45 roads of 124.66 km have been proposed under R&D proposals.
- 4 roads of liquid plastic have been proposed. State was asked to check the costs involved.
- Performance Report of WMM and surface dressing is required to be submitted by the State. State will submit by
  one week.
- 57.41 Km proposed on under technology with IRC specification and 67.25 Km under technology with IRC Accreditation which is more than the minimum length proposed.

## 6. Quality Issues:

- State asked for a rational distribution of NQMs to different PIUs and districts.
- 13 ATRs of completed works and 23 of ongoing works are remaining; state was asked to liquidate the same soon.
