No comments have been received from the members. It is proposed to confirm the Minutes of the previous meeting.</p> <p>No further action was required in respect of items no.1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18.</p> <p>Action taken on the issues requiring follow up:</p>	
	Item No. 5	Scheme for Young Interns for approval of GB
		The Committee ratified the same. This will be incorporated in the HR policy for NRRDA, currently under preparation by an Internal Committee appointed by MoRD.
	Item No.7	Review of decision taken regarding the issue of Service Tax, based on legal opinion received in the matter
		The matter has been referred to service tax authorities, as suggested by the EC. Their input is awaited. meanwhile, the inputs of the Legal counsel has been shared with all the STAs.
	Item No.10	Tripartite MOU between NRRDA+IAHE+NIRD for conduct of training programmes
		The matter is under consideration/process with IFD, MoRD.
	Item No.13	Meeting of the Performance Evaluation Committee for evaluating the performance of NQMs.
		The Executive Committee during its meeting held on 12 th December, 2015, while reviewing the observations

of the Performance Evaluation Committee held during 1-4 September, 2015, made the following observations:

- (i) Those NQMs whose reporting was not found in order should be kept under watch and if found unsatisfactory, they should be removed.

Follow-up Action

A provision to this effect already exists. Those NQMs whose reporting is not found in order are graded as 'Marginal'. These NQMs are retained. However, their performance is kept under watch and is reviewed in the subsequent PEC meeting. If the performance of these NQMs is found Unsatisfactory in the subsequent PEC meeting also, they are removed from the panel of NQMs.

Based on observations of the Performance Evaluation Committee during its meeting held from 1-4th September, 2015, the Selection Committee, Chaired by Addl. Secretary (RD), recommended de-panelsment of 6 NQMs due to their unsatisfactory performance.

- (ii) Increase in remuneration of NQMs.

Follow-up Action

The F&A Division of NRRDA vide their order dated 28th June, 2012, increased the amount of honorarium for per day of inspection from Rs 2,000/- to Rs 3,500/- (i.e an increase of Rs 1,500/-).

The issue regarding further increase in honorarium has been raised by NQMs at various fora including the refresher training programmes held by NRRDA from time to time. This seems to be justified as there is a gap of approx. four years since the last increase in June , 2012.

It is proposed that the amount of honorarium of NQMs per day may be increased from Rs 3,500/- to Rs 5,000/- (i.e an increase of Rs 1,500/-) . If approved by the Executive Committee, a proposal for increase in remuneration of NQMs will be prepared and sent to F&A Division for approval.

Item No. 19	<p>Any other item with permission of Chair</p> <p>As proposed by Dr. Praveen Kumar, (A member of the Executive Committee), a National Conference on 15 years PMGSY is being organised on 6-7th August, 2016 at IIT Roorkee. It has already been approved by DG, NRRDA and the Brochures have been circulated to all the States, STAs and PTAs. List of invitees is being finalized.</p>

Item No. II	<p>Empanelment of new NQMs</p> <p>A meeting of 19th Selection Committee for empanelment of new NQMs and performance review of the existing NQMs was held on 18th March, 2016 under the Chairmanship of Addl. Secretary (RD).</p> <p>Service and experience details of 48 candidates were placed before the Selection Committee. The Committee after perusal of details made the following recommendations based on the Selection criteria prescribed for the purpose:</p> <p>(i) Empanelment of new NQMs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 40 Candidates were recommended for empanelment subject to recommendation of the respective State Governments/production of pension papers. • 08 Candidates were not recommended for non-fulfilment of various provisions of Selection Criteria. <p>(ii) Delay in joining by NQMs:</p> <p>The matter regarding de-empanelment of those existing NQMs who take more than 3 months' time to join after their empanelment, without any genuine reasons (to be decided by the Competent Authority), was placed before the Selection Committee. The Committee deliberated upon 8 such cases of NQMs (<i>Details given in Annexure II of the Minutes of Selection Committee</i>) and recommended that all those NQMs who have taken more than 3 months' time to join as NQMs after their empanelment, without any genuine reasons (to be decided by the Competent Authority), may be de-empanelled. This recommendation of the Committee would be applicable for future such cases also.</p>

(iii) Non Compliance of Inspection Schedules issued by NRRDA

The issue regarding de-empanelment of those existing NQMs who fail to comply with the monthly schedule of inspection (issued by NRRDA) consecutively for 3 times without any genuine reasons (to be decided by the Competent Authority), was placed before the Selection Committee. The Committee deliberated upon 2 such cases of NQMs (*Details given in Annexure III of the Minutes of Selection Committee*) and recommended that all those NQMs who fail to comply with the monthly schedule of inspection (issued by NRRDA) consecutively for 3 times without any genuine reasons may be de-empanelled. This recommendation of the Committee would be applicable for future such cases also.

(iv) Frequency of Selection Committee Meetings

The issue regarding frequency of Meetings of Selection Committee was raised by some members. After deliberations, it was recommended by the Committee that the meetings of the Selection Committee may be held every 6 months.

Minutes of the Selection Committee placed at **Annexure IV**.

The above recommendations of the Selection Committee are submitted for ratification of the Executive Committee.

Item No.III Orientation-cum-training programme on Mobile Based Application Software for newly empanelled NQMs.

An Orientation-cum-training Programme focusing at Systems and procedures followed under 3rd tier of quality monitoring, sensitization about the critical issues concerning quality; and roles and responsibilities associated with 3rd tier of the quality monitoring for the newly empanelled NQMs was held at Indian Academy Of Highway Engineers (IAHE), Noida during 16-18th May, 2016.

During the three-day programme, presentations were made on important subjects like Programme Guidelines, Rural Roads Specifications, Use of new technology, Quality control testing process, Quality Assurance Handbook (QAHB) and Use of Mobile Application. On the last day of the programme, a field visit was arranged in district Ghaziabad for a practical demo on the site.

National Workshop to review Quality Assurance Handbook (QAHB)

An Expert Group constituted by NRRDA, under the Chairmanship of Shri S.C Sharma, DG (Retd.), MoRTH, was assigned the task of revision of Quality Assurance Handbook (QAHB). The draft prepared by the Expert Group was considered by the Peer Review Group during its meeting held on 3rd June, 2016 under the Chairmanship of Director, Central Road Research Institute (CRR). The amendments suggested by the Peer Review Group were incorporated in the revised draft and the same was discussed in the National Workshop on revision of Quality Assurance Handbook held at IAHE on 11th June, 2016.

During the workshop, officials from State Governments were also invited. In all there were 59 participants including NRRDA officials, Expert Group/ Peer Group members & State representatives. The Chairman and other members of the Expert Group made a presentation highlighting the salient features of the draft. This was followed by detailed discussion on various sections of the QAHB as indicated in the draft of Expert Group. The State Officials from Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand & West Bengal, while participating in the discussion gave feedback/inputs relating to Fly ash application, WBM & GSB gradation, dynamic & static load test for pile foundation, new technology viz. waste plastics, elaborate definition of sharp curve for hill roads & precise indication of GSB, WBM thickness for CC pavement etc.

The feedback/inputs received from the State Officials were taken note by the Expert Group members for appropriate incorporation in the final document of QAHB. The State officials were also requested to convey their inputs in writing to the Chairman of the Expert Group.

The final version of the QAHB document would be ready by 30th June, 2016.

Delegation of Financial Power to Director (F&A) in regard to hiring of conveyance and vehicle.

As per Delegation of Financial Power DG, NRRDA is the competent authority to sanction hiring of taxis/vehicles for official use. In NRRDA occasionally taxis are required to be hired for workshops and conferences/ training programmes. It is proposed to delegate the powers of hiring taxis for conferences/workshops/training programmes, upto Rs. 10,000/ in a month to Director (F&A) In NRRDA.

<p>Item No. VI</p>	<p>Setting up of the NTSA as a separate unit within NRRDA and renaming of NRRDA as NRIDA.</p> <p>The Cabinet has approved the new rural housing scheme-Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Gramin). In this regard a National Technical Support Agency (NTSA) to provide technical support to different aspects related to the scheme's implementation and to act as a SPV for disbursement of Loan amount from NABARD is required to be set up. The NTSA, as per the decision of the Ministry of Rural Development, is to be housed as a self contained multi-disciplinary wing under the National Rural Road Development Agency (NRRDA) reporting directly to Joint Secretary (RH). The NTSA will be manned by the personnel engaged through deputation and hired on contract. The contract would be limited to 1 year after the targeted year of 2022.</p> <p>2. In this regard, the following action is required to be taken by NRRDA:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) Memorandum of Association would need to be modified to add the additional activities, stipulating mainly that the NTSA will provide technical support to rural housing & access financial assistance for this purpose, from relevant Financial Institutions and International Partners ii) The name of NRRDA would be changed to National Rural Roads and Housing Development Agency (NRRHDA). iii) The composition of General Body & Executive Committee would need to be modified to include JS (RH) as a member as Additional DG NRIDA and as Deputy Chairman of the Executive Committee of NRIDA. iv) In principle approval of Ministry exists for the above. However, the formal approval of the Minister (RD) in his capacity as President, NRRDA would be sought in the GB meeting of NRRDA. <p>3. Submitted for information of the Executive Committee.</p>
<p>Item No. VII</p>	<p>Correction in fixation of remuneration of Sh. Brij Mohan and Sh. H.S. Saini working as consultants in NRRDA</p> <p>Sh. Brij Mohan and Sh. H.S. Saini are working in NRRDA since 15.3.2005 and 14.11.2012 respectively. Both the officers retired as Asstt. Controller of Accounts from O/o Controller General of Accounts. They were drawing a consultancy fee of Rs. 36000/- per month and</p>

Rs. 30035/- per month till June 2013.

In July, 2013 MoRD, issued an office order to regulate the Consultancy fee of the Consultants engaged in all the Divisions of Department of Rural Development. This office order, emphasized on the designation of the consultants at the time of their retirement for regulating the consultancy fee.

2. In July 2013, the Consultancy fee/emoluments of all the retired personnel engaged as Consultants in NRRDA, was revised, with the approval of the then D.G NRRDA, using the template of an MoRD order, regarding consultants engaged by MoRD. This order prescribed the rate of emolument based on the level at which the official had retired.

While fixing the remuneration of the consultants engaged in NRRDA the fixation of of Sh. Brij Mohan and Sh. H.S. Saini was done by projecting them as having retired at the rank of Under secretary, whereas both of them, retired in the grade of Section officer. Thus their remuneration was fixed higher than their entitlement.

This wrong fixation of remuneration resulted in an overpayment of Rs. 3,79,500/- each till March 2016. This case was submitted to DG NRRDA. DG directed F&A division to first fix the remuneration of both the consultants correctly and then submit the case to EC along with the details of overpayment. The remuneration of both the consultant has been re-fixed in accordance with the Officer order issued by MoRD, w.e.f. 1st April 2016 and the month wise details of overpayment is as below:

Rectification of Irregular designated post of Consultants as AD/DD

Retired officers have been engaged in NRRDA on contract basis against regular vacancy, for the past years. Their initial engagement was as consultants, However since the last few years the retired officers, who were earlier called consultants, have started carrying the designation of the regular post against which they are engaged. This incorrect procedure has also objected by Audit in the current year report and NRRDA has been asked to rectify the same. In 2012 a Committee of Directors of NRRDA, set up to implement the General Body's decision of July 2012, had recommended that the

	<p>designation of retired individual be `Consultant`, as per the decision of the General Body.</p> <p>It is stated that, unlike the serving officers, who are bound by their service rules and discipline, the retired have limited accountability. It is essential that they, as per practise in all similarly placed bodies, be designated as consultants. This is for information of the EC. The matter will be placed before the General Body as it pertains to terms and conditions of service for which the GB is the final authority.</p>

**Minutes of the 37th Meeting of the Executive Committee of the National Rural Roads
Development Agency**

The 37th meeting of the Executive Committee was held on 12th December 2015 in the Conference Hall of National Rural Road Development Agency (NRRDA), 5th Floor, 15 NBCC Tower, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi. The meeting was chaired by Shri Rajesh Bhushan, Director General, NRRDA and Joint Secretary (RC), MoRD. The following members were present in the meeting:-

The meeting started with the Chairman welcoming the members.

<i>Item No. 1</i>	<p>Confirmation of the Minutes of the 36th meeting of the Executive Committee of NRRDA and action taken thereon.</p> <p>Director (F&A) informed the members that the Minutes of the 36th Meeting were circulated to the members and no comments were received. The Executive Committee confirmed the said minutes and noted the action taken on the proceedings of the previous meeting.</p>	
<i>Item No.2</i>	<p>Ratification of Annual Report and Accounts of NRRDA duly audited for the period 2014-15</p> <p>The Annual Report and accounts of NRRDA, for the period 2014-15, were approved by the members. The members were informed that keeping in view the paucity of time, approval of the Minister Rural Development and President NRRDA, has been obtained for placing the</p>	

	<p>report before Parliament.</p> <p>The Director General expressed the need for timely tabling of the Annual Report of NRRDA, in Parliament.</p>
<i>Item No.3</i>	<p>Delegation of Financial Power related to release of Advertisement and publication to Director (F&A)</p> <p>EC was informed by DG NRRDA that NRRDA invariably faces shortage of officers, and needs to regularly advertise the vacancies, seeking applications for appointment on deputation basis and on contract.</p> <p>Currently all powers for release of advertisements through DAVP, rest with D.G. However, for the sake of administrative convenience and to save time, it was proposed to delegate such powers for release of advertisements through DAVP to the Director (F&A), NRRDA, up to a financial ceiling of Rs. 20,000/.</p> <p>Executive Committee approved the same.</p>
<i>Item No.4</i>	<p>Contract of retired personnel, serving in NRRDA.</p> <p>Director (F&A) informed the EC, that most of the retired personnel working in NRRDA, have been continuing to work in NRRDA, without any contract since August 2013. Therefore a Committee was constituted to look into the issue and to suggest a way forward. The Committee recommended regularisation of their contract with NRRDA till Dec. 2015, on account of the fact that the retired officials have been working in NRRDA and drawing salary and other benefits from here. However, from January 2016, their services should be based on a contract to be signed in advance. The EC was informed that the recommendations of the Committee will also be placed before GB.</p> <p>Executive Committee ratified the same.</p>
<i>Item No. 5</i>	<p>Scheme for Young Interns for approval of GB.</p> <p>The PMGSY programme is a programme with specific focus on well engineered roads, whose utility depends on ensuring high standards, proper management and the full involvement of the many stakeholders. Director (F&A) briefed the EC that in the background of shortage of skilled technical manpower, a scheme for young interns is under discussion. The draft scheme was shared with members of the EC. Inputs of Dr. Praveen Kumar have been incorporated in the draft.</p> <p>The Committee ratified the same.</p>

<p>Item No. 6</p>	<p>Extension of contract of young (civil) Engineers (Consultant)</p> <p>EC was informed by Director(F&A) that the contract of the following Young Civil Engineers, with NRRDA, had ended and keeping in view the recommendations of the Heads of respective Divisions, their contract has been renewed for another year as per the details below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shri Kiran Gowda from 08.10.2015 to 7.10.2016 2. Shri Vasanth Reddy from 12.10.2015 to 11.10.2016 3. Md. Hashim Khan from 25.9.2015 to 24.09.2016 <p>DG appreciated their knowledge and services the above young engineers have rendered to NRRDA.</p> <p>EC ratified the same.</p>
<p>Item No. 7</p>	<p>Review of decision taken regarding the issue of Service Tax, based on legal opinion received in the matter.</p> <p>Director (F&A) informed the EC that opinion of Legal Counsel has been obtained in this regard, according to which, NRRDA was not liable to reimburse Service Tax to State Technical Agencies as both NRRDA and STA's are part of Government.</p> <p>NRRDA has already communicated the same to all STAs. DG NRRDA directed that the opinion of the legal counsel be shared with all the STAs and PTAs.</p> <p>Dr Praveen Kumar proposed that the matter should be also taken up with the service tax authorities, by NRRDA. The same was agreed to by all.</p>
<p>Item No. 8</p>	<p>MOU between C-DAC & NRRDA and MoU between CGARD and NRRDA, for use of web and space technology respectively, in rural roads.</p> <p>Director (F&A), informed the members that an MoU has been signed between CDAC and NRRDA, for establishment of computerized data base for core rural road network through development of web based Geographical Information System (GIS) linked to road condition inventories. The project is to be implemented in 6 states in the first phase & subsequently in the balance PMGSY states, in the second phase.</p> <p>DG NRRDA also informed the EC members that another MoU is to be signed on the 16th of Dec.2015, between C-GARD and NRRDA, on use of space technology in rural roads project. The issue was discussed at length.</p>

	<p>Members raised the issue of possible contradictions between satellite imagery and actual alignments as per core network data. In such cases, ground level agencies should be consulted and there should be a transparent prescribed arbitration mechanism to resolve such contradictions.</p>	
<p>Item No. 9</p>	<p>Various posts in NRRDA</p> <p>Director(F&A) informed EC that advertisements have been published in the national dailies and letters have been issued seeking applications for the following posts, on deputation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Director (Project) /Tech 2 post (1/1) ▪ Jt. Director(Project/Tech) 5 posts (4/1) ▪ Dy. Director(F&A) 1 post ▪ Asstt. Director (Pro/Tech) 7 posts ▪ Young Engineers(Consultants) 2 posts <p>Notice seeking applications has also been uploaded on the PMGSY website. Last date for receiving the application is 31st December 2015.</p> <p>The Committee noted the action taken.</p>	
<p>Item No. 10</p>	<p>Tripartite MOU between NRRDA+IAHE+NIRD for conduct of training programmes.</p> <p>Director(F&A) informed the EC that a tripartite MOU between NRRD, IAHE and NIRD is under consideration and examination.</p> <p>DD(P-II) elaborated that the training have been categorised in two streams- 'Specialised' and 'Generic' as per details below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 'Specialised Training Programmes' relating to Planning, Design, Construction, Maintenance, 'Specialized operation and Management of rural roads including bridges shall be handled by the IAHE. 2. 'Generic Training Programmes' relating to capacity development other than specialised training shall be handled by the NIRD. <p>Dr. Praveen Kumar expressed concern over the fact that on some occasions, the same officials have been seen as being deputed for training repeatedly. To prevent such situations, he suggested that NRRDA should develop a computerised database of trainees and a two year embargo should be placed on deputing individuals for the next training programmes.</p>	

<p>Item No. 11</p>	<p>Meeting of Rajbhasha Samiti and conduct of the Hindi Pakhwara (14-29th September, 2015) & Publication of Hindi magazine "Smarika"</p> <p>Director(F&A) informed the EC that NRRDA organised the Hindi Pakhwara during the fortnight from 14-29 September 2015 and the DG released the in-house Magazine Smarika', which is a compilation of articles written by members of staff and personnel working in NRRDA.</p>
<p>Item No. 12</p>	<p>Conduct of Vigilance Awareness (26th - 30th October, 2015) Week</p> <p>Director (F&A) apprised the EC that the Vigilance Awareness Week was also observed in NRRDA.</p> <p>The EC noted the same.</p>
<p>Item No. 13</p>	<p>Meeting of the Performance Evaluation Committee for evaluating the performance of NQMs</p> <p>DD(P-III) briefed the Executive Committee about the meeting of the Performance Evaluation Committee, held during 1-4th sept.2015, for evaluating the performance of NQMs. He informed the EC that the Committee evaluated the performance of existing 47 NQMs who conducted 20 or more inspections during Jan 2014 to 2015. According to evaluation 14 NQMs were outstanding, 23 NQMs were satisfactory, 4 NQMs were marginal and 6 NQMs were unsatisfactory and were removed from the panels of NQMs.</p> <p>While reviewing the inspection report, some NQMs reporting were not found in order. Members suggested that they should be kept under watch and if found unsatisfactory, they should be removed.
