Subject: Release of 52.356715 Crore as 2nd installment Grants-in-aid to State Government of Madhya Pradesh for the year 2019-20 under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) -reg.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to **Rs.52,35,67,150/- (Rupees Fifty Two Crore Thirty Five Lakh Sixty Seven Thousand One Hundred Fifty Rupees only)** to the State Government of Madhya Pradesh as Central assistance under PMGSY-II, Batch-I (Regular), 2018-19 for the Financial Year 2019-20.

2. The proposed amount of Rs. 52.356715 Crore and the interest earned by the State Government are adjusted as per the details given below:

State Share of Rs. 54.04 cr. is to be released against the above proposed release under PMGSY-II, Batch-I of 2018-19.

3. The State Government must transfer these funds to **Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Development Authority (MPRRDA)** within 3 working days positively from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:

4. **Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA)** has nominated Shri M. P. Singh Niranjana, Chief General Manager (Finance), MPRRDA as the Empowered Officer.

5. The funds transferred by the State Government to MPRRDA shall be kept in a separate saving Bank Account No. 1793139758 in Central Bank of India (IFSC Code-CBIN0283312), 9 Arera Hills Branch, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. It shall be ensured by Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA) that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of the Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA) shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.

6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorized Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.

7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA), Bhopal.

8. The Accounts of the grantee institution will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry in terms of Rule 211 (1) of the General Financial Rules.

9. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose.


