I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to Rs. 65,58,32,500/- (Rupees Sixty Five Crore Fifty Eight Lakh Thirty Two Thousand and Five Hundred only) to Panchayati Raj and Rural Development Department under the State Government of Andhrah Pradesh for Road Connectivity Project on Left Wing Extremism Affected Area (RCPLWEA), as Central assistance (Programme Fund) under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the Financial Year 2019-20.

3. The State Government must transfer these funds to Andhra Pradesh State Rural Road Development Agency (APSRRDA) within 3 working days positively from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:

4. Andhra Pradesh State Rural Roads Development Authority (APSRRDA) has nominated Shri B Subba Reddy, Engineer-in-Chief as the Empowered Officer of APSRRDA.

- 5. The funds transferred by the State Government to APSRRDA shall be kept in a separate saving Bank Account No. 110510011001045 (IFSC Code-ANDB 0001105), Andhra Bank, Banjara Hills Branch, Hyderabad-500034. It shall be ensured by Andhra Pradesh State Rural Roads Development Agency (APSRRDA) that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of the Andhra Pradesh State Rural Roads Development Agency (APSRRDA) shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.
- 6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorized Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.
- 7. The Accounts of the grantee institution will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry in terms of Rule 211 (1) of the General Financial Rules.
- 8. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose.
- 9. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Andhra Pradesh State Rural Roads Development Agency (ASPRRDA).
