3. General & DPR issues

(i) The issue of Institutional framework of BRRDA was discussed in detail. The Committee observed that there is no bridge expert in position under BRRDA for supervision/monitoring and inspection of the large number of bridge works in the State. The State was advised to work out the requirement of bridge experts in consultation with NRIDA and engage the required number of bridge experts both for supervision and monitoring of planning, design and construction works and separately (as SQMs) for inspection purposes. The instant proposal of the State shall be further considered for approval only after the State put in place the desired Governance

framework for proper execution of the proposal within the time-line of the scheme. It was also observed that state already has more than 500 LSBs under construction. Any governance framework should include the requirement of these and the prospective sanctions of LSBs.

- ii) All the proposals of left-out bridges in pipeline for sanction under PMGSY-I & II are required to be completed latest by March, 2022. The projects which are not completed by the said date would be frozen on 31st March, 2022 for any activity under PMGSY and the expenditure on such works will then have to be borne by the State Government. The State was advised to chalk out plan of execution accordingly with sufficient execution capacity in place.
- iii) Completion of bidding process in the State takes considerable time. The Statewas advised to complete the bidding process within the specified time line. The state needs to put in place a system to award the work in the in minimum possibletimeline. The state should come up with a concrete plan so as to award theseprojects withing a tight time-line so that works can be completed by March 2022positively.
- iv) Steel quantity in the DPRs, which were found abnormally high at the time of themeeting of the Pre-Empowered Committee, has been reduced by the State byaround 1085.07 MT. The State was advised to get DPRs re-checked by the STA toensure that reduction in steel quantity is in accordance with the requirements andwill not affect the overall strength. NRIDA was also asked to get it checked from anindependent agency/ experts. NRIDA should also investigate as to how the STA haspassed these DPRs with irrational quantity of steel.
- v) DPRs have not yet been scrutinized by the PTA. State was asked to ensure that atleast 10% of the DPRs are scrutinized by the PTA.

4. Quality

Attention of State was invited especially to the large number of observation of NQMpending for want of ATR from the State, besides the other issues of Quality likeestablishment of QC lab, inspection by SQM, U% in ongoing, completed andmaintenance works based on NQM inspections. It was observed that 93 ATRs of NQM observations in respect of Completed works and 166 ATRs of Ongoing worksare pending with the State. Out of these, 2 ATRs of completed work and 11 ATRs ofongoing work are pending for more than 5 years. State assured immediate action onquality issues.

Recommendation of the Committee

Subject to the above observations and concurrent action stipulated in the foregoing paras, the Empowered Committee recommended the proposals at Para 2 above.

The meeting ended with Vote of Thanks to and from the Chair.
