Summary of Discussions held in the meeting to review the progress of Implementation of Geographical Information System (GIS) under PMGSY held on 18th August, 2017-reg

A review meeting to assess the current status of the Implementation of GIS for PMGSY was held under the chairmanship of Secretary (RD) on 18th August, 2017 at MoRD, New Delhi. Additional Secretary (RD), AS&FA, JS (RC) & DG, NRRDA, Director (RC) MoRD, Assistant Secretary (RC), Director (Technical), Director (P-II in charge), Director (P-III), Director (F&A), NRRDA, GIS Team from, C-DAC were present in the meeting. Representatives from 12 States namely Gujarat, UP, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Rajasthan, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, J&K and Jharkhand attended the meeting. The name of the officers attended the meeting is given at Annexure.

- 2. JS (RC) while welcoming the participants, outlined the importance of the project and emphasized the need for completion of the project as per the timelines made in the MoU, which was signed between NRRDA and CDAC on 27.10.2015. He briefly explained the deliverables of CDAC and States and informed that some of the deliverables of both the States and CDAC are behind the schedule. While 4 States namely Himachal Pradesh, Odisha, Haryana and Uttarakhand have submitted entire data to CDAC after due Quality Check at the level of CDAC and are ready to get hosted remaining States are still in the Process of either submitting pilot block data or entire State data. He requested all the States to submit the entire data to CDAC on priority basis so that the project can be implemented as per the timelines stipulated, ie. January 2018.
- 3. In his opening remarks, Secretary (RD) opined that the pace of the project requires to be speeded up considering the importance of the project. Secretary (RD) highlighted that the project is given topmost priority by the Ministry, as we are looking for digitized database for roads as being done for MGNREGA and PMAGY assets to ensure better transparency and accountability. He requested all the States and C-DAC to jointly work to expedite the processes, which are behind the schedule to ensure that the project is implemented by January 2018 as per MOU. He further assured that all genuine supports like human resource and requisite funding for technology needs will be provided to C-DAC on a merit basis.
- 4. Shri. Sajeevan, Joint Director C-DAC made a power point presentation highlighting the background, over view of the project. He also highlighted the challenges in the implementation of the project like spatial accuracy, integration of various layers etc. and also put forth the way ahead for smooth implementation of the project. Director (Technical) NRRDA suggested that one layer of non-conventional construction (R&D) material may be added to the present layers of the GIS to have a better knowledge of availability of such materials for road construction.
- 5. After due deliberation, following timelines have been set for the States and CDAC as agreed to by them for various deliverables for the implementation of the project.
