Sub: Improvement in existing eMARG (DLP) module in compliance to NRIDA SBD.

Dear Sir/Madam,

NRIDA has been actively monitoring the progress of states in eMARG since its inception. Through interactions with the states, it has been noticed that there are concerns in compliance with NRIDA SBD provisions. To address these concerns, certain changes in eMARG are being implemented to align it with NRIDA SBD. The details of these changes are outlined below:-

1. As per SBD clause 38.2 (f) the contractor shall submit monthly bills by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the next month (on web-based software utility e- Marg) and if the bill for a month is not received from the Contractor, he forfeits his right for the payment and no payment shall be due to the contractor. It is observed that in many cases, despite the district officials having conducted all the required activities on their part i.e., Routine Inspection and Performance Evaluation, due to the non-submission of bills by the contractor, PIU cannot proceed with the billing process. As of now, there are 61,440 bills pending for submission by the contractor, amounting to Rs. 179 crore. This leads to the display of a huge pendency on the part of States.

To resolve this issue "eMARG is being configured so that after the stipulated 10 days allowed to submit bills, a final notice will be sent to the contractor on mobile app, giving the last chance of 10 days for submission, failing which the bill will be automatically submitted by the system. Since these bills would in any case be late submissions, irrespective of RI or PE, these bills will be construed to be zero by the system in compliance of the SBD clauses as mentioned above and no payment for that period will be admissible to the contractor".

2. As per SBD clause 38.2 The payment for routine maintenance of roads to the Contractor is performance based. The performance of roads is assessed on e-Marg, through regular Routine Inspection (RI) and Performance Evaluation (PE) by the engineer. However, it is noticed that in some cases RI and PE are not being carried out by PIUs regularly. In compliance with the NRIDA SBD, eMARG is being configured so as not to allow PE, if RI is missed for more than one time in a DLP year for the work. In all such cases where RI is missed (except for maximum one in a DLP year), the bill for that month will be made zero by the system. Maximum relaxation of one missed RI per DLP year would be available, provided consecutive RIs are not missed from one DLP year to the other.

3. There is a provision in NRIDA SBD that the balance performance security, security deposit can be released only after satisfactory completion of defect liability period. Further, SBD section 4 Part 1 GCC clause 32.1 states that "The Engineer shall give notice to the Contractor of any Defects before the end of the Defects Liability Period, which begins from the Completion Date and ends after five years. The Defects Liability Period shall be extended for as long as the Defects remain to be corrected".

In compliance with the above, e-MARG is being configured to ascertain the satisfactory performance of roads during the 5-year Defect Liability Period i.e. having secured at least 80% marks for the entire period. Accordingly, e-MARG will calculate the period of non-satisfactory performance of road while generating Defect Liability Certificate. The non satisfactory period will be added to determine the extended period of DLP. The release of performance security, security deposit shall be allowed only when eMARG generated defect liability completion certificate mentions no extension of defect liability period based upon the satisfactory performance of the road. The finance wing of SRRDA shall ensure compliance of the same and release the deposits only after eMARG system generated Defect Completion Certificate. The format of Defect Liability Certificate as generated in eMARG is enclosed as Annexure-I.

In view of the above, it is advised that all concerned, including contractors, are suitably apprised.
