

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revision of physical targets (Road length & Habitation) under PMGSY for the year 2018-19 .

The undersigned is directed to say that on the basis of the discussions with the States during Regional Review Meetings (RRMs) and balance road length & habitations (as per OMMAS), physical targets for the year 2018-19 have been revised from 61,000 km to 58,000 km in r/o road length and from 19,725 to 15,000 in r/o habitations. State-wise details of the same are given at **Annexure**.

2. State Governments are requested to accelerate the pace of work for the rest of the financial year in order to complete PMGSY-I targets by March 2019.
