Subject: Inspection of PMGSY projects by State Quality Monitors (SQMs) during year 2021-22 – regarding

Madam/Sir,

This is regarding inspections of PMGSY and RCPLWE works by State Quality Monitors (SQMs) and achieving the targeted number of inspections during the year 2021-22. The targets of SQM inspections for the year 2021-22, were conveyed vide letter no. NRRDA-PO 17(28)/1/2019-Director (P-III) dated 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2021. Some of the states have informed that the assigned targets are very high and are not based on completed and ongoing number of works in the state. The targets have been revised and conveyed to all the states vide letter no. NRRDA-P-017(28)/1/2019-Dir (P-III) dated August, 26, 2021. A copy of the revised targets is enclosed for ready reference.

- 2. It has been observed that the number of inspections conducted by SQMs till July, 2021 are substantially low. The number of SQMs available with the States are also much lower than the requirement conveyed by the NRIDA. These issues have been discussed in the monthly review meetings, with a request to increase the number of SQMs and also ensure inspections of all the ongoing and completed works by the SQMs both for PMGSY & RCPLWE projects.
- 3. The State Quality Coordinator (SQC) of PMGSY works in your state are assigning works to only some SQMs and the SQC of RCPLWE works is assigning works to some other identified SQMs only. It is to inform that on OMMAS data of SQMs of the State both for PMGSY and RCPLWE works, has been maintained at one place and all SQMs are available for assignment of works by both the SQCs.

- 4. From analysis of OMMAS data, it is observed that not all the SQMs are assigned duties every month and the number of works assigned to SQMs are also not as per the guidelines. SQMs are being assigned only one district in a month and only 5-6 works. It is expected that SQMs are assigned two districts and around 8 to 10 works in each of the districts every month.
- 5. It is suggested that in order to achieve the targeted number of inspections, all the SQMs willing to take up inspections in a month, be assigned duties in two districts for inspection of works at least for 5 days in each district. SQC of RCPLWE works can assign works to those SQMs who are presently working for PMGSY only. Similarly SQC of PMGSY can assign works to those SQMs, who are presently working for RCPLWE only. SQCs of PMGSY & RCPLWE should work in coordination to ensure that assignments are given to all the willing NQMs for ensuring inspection of works as per 2<sup>nd</sup> tier guidelines.
- 6. In view of above, you are requested to ensure necessary directions to the SQCs and also to State Quality Monitors (SQMs).
