I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to Rs. **245,00,00,000 (Rupees Two Hundred and Forty Five crore only)** to the State Government of Assam as additional fund (3rd installment) of Central assistance under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) towards the Financial Year 2021-22.

2. The total amount of **Rs. 245.00 crore** being released in the present sanction has been adjusted as per the details given below:

- 3. The State Government shall transfer these funds along with the corresponding State Share to Assam State Road Board (ASRB) within a maximum of 15 days from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India.
- 4. Assam State Road Board (ASRB) has nominated **Shri. B Takuldar, Additional Chief Engineer (PWD),** Government of Assam, Chandmari, Guwahati-781003 as the Empowered Officer of ASRB.
- 5. The funds released by the State Government shall be kept in a separate Savings Bank Account No. 10566991446 (IFSC Branch Code No. SBIN0000221), State Bank of India, New Guwahati Branch, Dist. Kamrup, Guwahati-781021. It shall be ensured by the Assam State Road Board (ASRB) that the Programme Implementing Units (PIUs) in the districts have access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of Assam State Road Board (ASRB) shall communicate to the bank the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's said bank account for the purpose of this sanction.
- 6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the bank regarding the names of authorized payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.

- 7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Assam State Road Board (ASRB).
- 8. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose.
- 9. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released should be mandatorily remitted to the respective Consolidated Funds on pro-rata basis in terms of Rule 230(8) of GFR, 2017. Interest earned should be clearly and separately depicted in PFMS, scheme-specific portals integrated with PFMS and in MIS provided by the banks.
- 10. The accounts of the grantee institutions will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Internal Audit of the O/o the CCA of the Ministry in terms of **Rule 236(1)** of the General Financial Rules.
- 11. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No. 86** Department of Rural Development (2021-22).
