Subject: Release of 1st installment of Administrative Funds to the State Government of Madhya Pradesh under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the Financial Year 2021-22-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Grants-inaid amounting to Rs.2,54,50,000/- (Rupees Two Crore Fifty Four Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) towards 1st Installment of Administrative Funds to the State Government of Madhya Pradesh as Central Assistance under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the Financial Year 2021-22.

2. The State Government shall transfer these funds to Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA) within a maximum period of 15 days from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:-

- 3. As per para 10 of the Ministry of Finance O.M dated 23.3.2021 'The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released should be mandatorily remitted to the respective Consolidated Funds on pro-rata basis in terms of Rule 230(8) of GFR, 2017. Interest earned should be clearly and separately depicted in PFMS, scheme-specific portals integrated with PFMS and in MIS provided by the banks.' MPRRDA is requested that the interest earned during the year 2020-21 may be remitted as per the above guidelines.
- 4. Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Development Authority (MPRRDA) has nominated Shri Shashank Misha, Chief Executive Officer (CEO), MPRRDA as the Empowered Officer.
- 5. The funds transferred by the State Government to MPRRDA shall be kept in a separate Savings Bank Account No. 3442247194, (IFSC Code: CBIN0283312), Central Bank Of India, Arera Hills Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. It shall not be transferred to any other account of the Agency without approval. It shall be ensured by the State Government that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered

Officer of the Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA), shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.

- 6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorized Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.
- 7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA).
- 8. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose
- 9. The Accounts of the grantee institution will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the internal Audit of the O/o the CCA of the Ministry of Rural Development in terms of Rule 236 (1) of the General Financial Rules.
- 10. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No.86** Department of Rural Development (2021-22):
