Subject: Release of Grants-in-aid to State Government of Uttar Pradesh as 1st Tranche of 1st installment of Programme fund under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the year 2022-23-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of Grants-in-aid (Programme Fund) amounting to **Rs. 499,00,00,000/- (Rupees Four Hundred Ninety Nine Crore only)** to the State Government of Uttar Pradesh as 1st Tranche of 1st installment of Central assistance under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) during the Financial Year 2022-23.

2. The amount of Rs. 499.00 crore is towards 1st Tranche of 1st installment under PMGSY, (Batch-II, 2016-17). The amount of Rs. 499.00 crore is adjusted as per the details given below:

3. **The State Government must transfer these funds alongwith corresponding State Share to Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads Development Agency (UPRRDA) within a maximum period of 15 days from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases.** The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:



4. **Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads Development Agency (UPRRDA)** has nominated Shri Bhanu Chandra Goswami, Chief Executive Officer, UPRRDA as the Empowered Officer.

5. The funds transferred by the State Government to UPRRDA shall be kept in a separate **saving Bank Account No. 10616665805 in State Bank of India, Jawahar Bhavan, (Branch Code No. 6144),(IFS Code No.SBIN0006144), Lucknow.** It shall not be transferred to any other account of the Agency without approval. It shall be ensured by the State Government that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of the **Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads Development Agency (UPRRDA)**, shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.

6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorized Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.
7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from **Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads Development Agency (UPRRDA), Lucknow.**
8. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose
9. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released should be mandatorily remitted to the respective Consolidated Funds on pro-rata basis in term of Rule 230(8) of GFR, 2017. Interest earned should be clearly and separately depicted in PFMS, scheme- specific portals integrated with PFMS and in MIS provided by the banks.
10. The State Government shall ensure the integration of the state treasury with PFMS and all the entries should be reflected on PFMS.
11. The State Nodal Agency shall ensure that sufficient budget provisions are made in the state budget before the request of further funds release.
12. The Accounts of the grantee institution will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the internal Audit of the O/o the CCA of the Ministry of Rural Development in terms of **Rule 236(1)** of the General Financial Rules.
13. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No. 87** Department of Rural Development (**2022-23**):
