**Subject—Release of Grants-in-aid (Programme Fund) to State Government of Sikkim as 1<sup>st</sup> tranche of 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of Annual Allocation (AA) for year 2020-21 under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY).**

Sir,

1.1 I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to **Rs. 58,67,50,000 (Rupees Fifty Eight Crore Sixty Seven Lakh and Fifty Thousand only)** to the State Government of Sikkim as Central assistance towards balance payment of 1<sup>st</sup> tranche of 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of programme fund under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the **Financial Year 2020-21**.

1.2 The above said release amount of **Rs. 58.675 crore** is being adjusted as per the details given below:

2.1 The funds will be released to the State Government as per the Bank details given below:-

2.2. The State Government shall transfer these funds along with the corresponding State share to **Sikkim Rural Roads Development Agency (SRRDA) within 15 working days positively from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases.**

3. The funds released by the State Government shall be kept in a separate savings **Bank Account No. 11018614444 (IFS Code No.SBIN0000232), State Bank of India, Gangtok Branch, M.G Road, Sikkim-737101**. It shall be ensured by the Sikkim Rural Roads Development Agency (SRRDA) that the Programme Implementing Units (PIUs) in the districts have access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of Sikkim Rural Roads Development Agency (SRRDA) shall communicate to the bank the names of the Authorized Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's said bank account for the purpose of this sanction.

4. Sikkim Rural Roads Development Agency has nominated **Shri L D Lamtha, Principal Chief Engineer, Rural Management & Development Department**, as the Empowered Officer of Sikkim Rural Roads Development

Agency (SRRDA). The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:-

5. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the bank regarding the names of authorized payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.
6. No Utilization Certificate is pending from **Sikkim Rural Roads Development Agency (SRRDA)**.
7. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose
8. The accounts of the grantee institutions will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry in terms of Rule 211(1) of the General Financial Rules.
9. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No.85** Department of Rural Development (2020-21):  


