2. The amount of 12.14725 Crore is towards release of Programme adjusted against the Sanction letter dated 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2018, the details are given below:-

In case of non transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. Besides, the State Government would be liable to pay interest @12% for the period of delay beyond the specified period. 4. Road Construction Department (RCD), RCPLWEA, Bihar has nominated Shri Chandra Shekhar, Chief General Manager, Bihar State Road Development

Corporation, Patna as Empowered Officer of Road Construction Department (RCD), RCPLWEA, Bihar, Patna.

- 5. The funds released by the State Government shall be kept in a separate savings Bank Account No. 37472809907 (IFS Code No.SBIN0006379), (MICR Code No.800002006), State Bank of India, Bailey Road Branch, Vishweshwaraiya Bhavan, Patna, Bihar. It shall be ensured by the Road Construction Department (RCD), RCPLWEA, Bihar that the Programme Implementing Units (PIUs) in the districts have access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of Road Construction Department (RCD) shall communicate to the bank the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's bank account for the purpose of this sanction.
- 6. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the bank regarding the names of authorized payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.
- 7. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Road Construction Department (RCD), Bihar.
- 8. Utilisation Certificte should be submitted within 12(twelve) months of the closure of the financial year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the ledger accounts for the prupose.
- 9. The accounts of the grantee institutions will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry in terms of Rule 211 (1) of the General Financial Rules.
