I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to Rs.69,07,500 (Rupees Sixty Nine lakh Seven thousand Five Hundred only) towards 1st Installment of Administrative Funds to the State Government of Madhya Pradesh as Central Assistance for Road Connectivity Project on Left Extremism Area (RCPLWEA) under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the Financial Year 2017-18.

2. Vide this Ministry's letter of even no. dated 3rd October, 2017, the Ministry has accorded clearance for the proposal as per summary given below:-

4. The State Government must transfer these funds to Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA) within 3 working days positively from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. Besides, the State Government would be liable to pay interest @ 12% for the period of delay beyond the specified period. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:-

5. Madhya Pradesh Rural Road Development Authority (MPRRDA) has nominated Shri Dinesh Suhane, Chief General Manager (Finance), MPRRDA as the Empowered Officer.

- The funds transferred by the State Government to M. P. Gramin Sarak Vikas Pradhikaran, Bhopal shall be kept in a separate Savings Bank Account No. 10637865037, (IFSC Code: SBIN0007242), State Bank of India (07242), Vindhyachal Bhawan, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. It shall not be transferred to any other account of the Agency without approval. It shall be ensured by the State Government that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of the Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA), shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.
- The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorized Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.
- No Utilization Certificate is pending from Madhya Pradesh Rural Roads Development Authority (MPRRDA).
- The accounts of the grantee institutions will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Internal Audit of the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry in terms of Rule 211 (1) of the General Financial Rules.
