In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. Besides, the State Government would be liable to pay interest @ 12% for the period of delay beyond the specified period.
- 4. Punjab Roads & Bridges Development Board (PRBDB), Chandigarh has nominated Shri Yogesh Gupta, Chief Engineer, as the Empowered Officer. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:

The funds shall be kept in a separate saving Bank Account No. 10506608012 in State Bank of India, (Branch Code No.3246), IFSC Code-SBIN 0003246, Sector-7, Madhya Marg, Chandigarh. It shall be ensured by the Punjab Roads & Bridges Development Board (PRBDB), the Programme Implementing Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are

allowed to be utilized only by the Executive Agency/Agencies for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of PRBDB shall communicate to the Bank the names of the Authorized Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's said Bank Account for the purpose of this sanction.

- 6. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Punjab Roads & Bridges Development Board (PRBDB), Chandigarh.
- The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose.
- 8. The accounts of the grantee institutions will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Internal Audit of the O/o the CCA of the Ministry of Rural Development in terms of Rule 211 (1) of the General Financial Rules.
