**Subject: Release of Rs. 3.37725 Cr. as 1<sup>st</sup> installment of Central Share of Programme Funds to State Government of Uttar Pradesh for Road Connectivity Project on Left Extremism Area(RCPLWEA) under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the year 2017-18-reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of Grants-in-aid amounting to **Rs. 3, 37,72,500 (Rupees Three Crore Thirty Seven Lakh Seventy Two Thousand Five Hundred only)** towards 1<sup>st</sup> Installment of Programme Funds to the State Government of Uttar Pradesh as Central Assistance for Road Connectivity Project on Left Extremism Area (RCPLWEA) under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) for the Financial Year 2017-18.

2. Vide this Ministry's letter of even no. dated 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2018, the Ministry has accorded clearance for the proposal as per summary given below:-

3. The amount of Rs. 3.37725 Crore released in the present sanction has been adjusted as per the details given below:

4. The State Government must transfer these funds to **Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads Development Agency (UPRRDA)** within 3 working days positively from the date of receipt of these funds. In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. Besides, the State Government would be liable to pay interest @ 12% for the period of delay beyond the specified period. The State Government is required to endorse a copy of the release order to the Government of India at the following address:

5. **Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads Development Agency (UPRRDA)** has nominated Shri Sudhesh Kumar Ojha, Chief Executive Officer, UPRRDA as the Empowered Officer.

6. The funds transferred by the State Government to UPRRDA shall be kept in a separate **saving Bank Account No. 10616665805 in State Bank of India, Jawahar Bhavan, (Branch Code No. 6144),(IFSCCodeNo.SBIN0006144), Lucknow.** It shall not be transferred to any other account of the Agency without approval. It shall be ensured by the State Government that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose

of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of the **Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads Development Agency (UPRRDA)**, shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised Signatories, who will be issuing cheques on the Agency's Bank account for the purpose of this sanction.

7. The Empowered Officer shall issue standing instructions to the Bank regarding the names of Authorized Payees and their designated account details and the amounts admissible to each payee. He will also specify limits on monthly payments as per the agreed work programme for the respective package.

8. No Utilization Certificate is pending from Uttar Pradesh Rural Roads Development Agency (UPRRDA), Lucknow.

9. The Utilization Certificate should be submitted within 12 (Twelve) months of the closure of Financial Year which shall include interest accrued. Interest accrued should be computed based on the details of the Ledger Account maintained for the purpose

10. The Accounts of the grantee institution will be audited by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the internal Audit of the O/o the CCA of the Ministry of Rural Development in terms of Rule 211 (1) of the General Financial Rules.

11. The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Accounts under **Demand No.82** Department of Rural Development (2017-2018):

- 3601 - Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head).
- 06 - Centrally Sponsored Schemes
- 101 - Central Assistance Share
- 30 - Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana
- 30.02 - Roads Project for LWE affected Areas
- 30.02.35 - Grants for creation of Capital assets

12. The Pay & Accounts Officer, Ministry of Rural Development will be the Drawing and Disbursing Officer for this purpose. The amount mentioned in Para-1 above will be transferred to State Government of Uttar Pradesh.
