- An amount of Rs. 196.115 crore is released in the present sanction along with adjustment of Rs. 1.2 26.31 crore accrued as interest by the State during the year 2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16. The adjustment details are given below:

In case of non-transfer beyond this period, Central Government may be constrained to stop further releases. Besides, the State Government would be liable to pay interest @ 12% for the period of delay beyond the specified period. It shall be ensured by Uttarakhand Rural Roads Development Agency (URRDA) that the Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) in the districts have ready access to the funds and the funds held in the specified account are allowed to be utilized only by the Executing Agency/Agencies only for the purpose of approved works under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana. The Empowered Officer of Uttarakhand Rural Roads Development Agency (URRDA) shall communicate to the Bank, the names of the Authorised
